Segers Site receives AdvantageSite designation

BIRMINGHAM, Ala., July 24 – Segers Site in Baldwin County has received an Alabama AdvantageSite designation.

The AdvantageSite program requires that community economic development organizations provide documentation specific to a proposed industrial site, including a set of standard data related to ownership/control, environmental and geotechnical conditions, and infrastructure status. Sites must also meet size, zoning and accessibility requirements.

The 39.5-acre site is located within the city limits of Fairhope. The industrial site is approximately 14 miles or a 24-minute drive to Interstate 10. All utilities for the park are at the site. The site was originally part of the Fairhope Industrial Park but is now owned by the Aviation Industrial Group Inc. The application process was managed by Lee Johnson of the Baldwin County Economic Development Alliance with a team of local entities supporting and/or participating in the process.

"This designation shows that the Aviation Industrial Group Inc. has invested the resources and time necessary to position the site for development in the near future," said Christo Kok, CEO of Segers Aero Corp. "We are grateful to the partners who made their time and resources available as we worked to achieve this designation and look forward to working with them and the Baldwin County Economic Development Alliance in marketing the Segers site as an AdvantageSite."

The program is jointly sponsored by the Alabama Department of Commerce, Alabama Gas Corp., Alabama Power Co., the North Alabama Industrial Development Association, PowerSouth Energy Cooperative, and coordinated by EDPA. AdvantageSite is a teamwork approach with representatives from each of the entities actively participating in application reviews and on-site visits to prospective AdvantageSite designees.
