### **Prattville South Industrial Park receives AdvantageSite designation**

BIRMINGHAM, Ala., November 19 – Prattville South Industrial Park in Autauga County has received an Alabama AdvantageSite designation.

The AdvantageSite program requires that community economic development organizations provide documentation specific to a proposed industrial site, including a set of standard data related to ownership/control, environmental and geotechnical conditions, and infrastructure status. Sites must also meet size, zoning and accessibility requirements.

The 381-acre industrial park is located within the Prattville city limits on Autauga County Road 4. The site is less than four miles from Interstate 65. The site is owned by the City of Prattville. One unique aspect of the park is that it can be served by two rail providers. The application process was managed locally by the Prattville Area Chamber of Commerce with a team of local entities supporting and/or participating in the process.

Amy Brabham, economic development director for the Prattville Area Chamber of Commerce, said the AdvantageSite designation for the Prattville South Industrial Park puts another seal of approval on being prepared for industrial activity in Prattville and Autauga County.

“We are confident this continues to put our community in prime shape for business location,” she said. “We want folks all over the world to know that Prattville and Autauga County are open for business.”

The program is jointly sponsored by the Alabama Department of Commerce, Alabama Gas Corp., Alabama Power Co., the North Alabama Industrial Development Association, PowerSouth Energy Cooperative, and coordinated by EDPA. AdvantageSite is a teamwork approach with representatives from each of the entities actively participate in application reviews and on-site visits to prospective AdvantageSite designees.
